

Instructions for receiving waste

From Ships to The Works Contractors

- 1- The contractor's obligation to receive an assignment order or authorization from the shipping agency before starting work .
- 2- The contractor's obligation to work receive waste at the times specified by the authority .
- 3- The contractor's obligation to submit a request for notification of the movement of his aid or barge to the central administration of the movement and a copy of it to the general administration for environmental protection before starting the movement of the aid or barge provided that he clarifies the notification (the name of the ship / number of barge / pier number / received data / moving hour) .
- 4- The contractor's obligation to submit a statement of delivery of ship waste to the final disposal company when these companies receive wastes from ships indicating (waste type / quantity / received data / the final disposal company) it should be stamped and signed by contractor and the final disposal company .
- 5- The contractor's obligation to record waste movement data , starting from receiving it from the ship until its safe disposal , in the waste movement log , which is printed and issued by the Authority .
- 6- The contractor's obligation to keep the waste movement record for a period of on less than one full year , as it is inspected periodically by the general administration for environmental protection .
- 7- The contractor's obligation to complete the data related to the receipt of the waste receipt from the ship . provided that it is signed and sealed by ship's captain and submits a copy of it to the general administration for environmental protection monthly. if he doesn't commit to delivering the receipts financial fines will be imposed in accordance with the decision to return the thing to its original origin issued by the chairman of the board or directors .

- 8- Commitment to separated barges for receiving waste according to the type of waste according with environmental requirement .
- 9- Commitment to proper appearance of the existing labor in terms of wearing protective gear and the way of dealing with foreign ships .
- 10- Commitment to obtaining the necessary environmental approvals for handling and transporting waste from ships .
- 11- Commitment to ensuring the good technical condition of the barges and ensure that there are safety means in them .
- 12- Obligation to in form the General Authority of Alexandria Port of any accidents of spillage of oily residues or harmful materials or the occurrence of a fire .
